## Overview

This bill provides that if a victim dies before or after a request for restitution is made or order is issued, the victim's estate may request or enforce an order on the victim's behalf. Provisions are made for formal and informal probate.

*Background:* Under statute, a "victim" has a right to request and receive restitution. The term "victim" includes family members of a deceased victim; however, statute does not specifically reference the victim's estate and its expenses.
