Definitions. Adds § 325F.174. Defines, for purpose of this act, "child" and "children's product."

Provides an immediate effective date.

Formaldehyde in children's products; ban. Adds § 325F.175. Prohibits sale of children's products that contain formaldehyde or ingredients that chemically degrade under normal conditions to release formaldehyde. The prohibition begins January 1, 2014.

Provides an immediate effective date.

Formaldehyde replacement chemicals. Adds § 325F.176. Prohibits manufacturers from replacing prohibited chemicals with a chemical designated as a chemical of high concern under Minnesota Statutes § 116.9402.

Provides an immediate effective date.
