1 Bisphenol-A in children's food containers. Adds § 325F.174.

Subd. 1. Prohibition. Prohibits manufacturers and wholesalers from selling a children's food container that contains bisphenol-A.

Subd. 2. Definitions. Defines, for purposes of this section, "children's food" and "container."

Provides an immediate effective date.

2 Bisphenol-A replacement chemicals. Adds § 325F.175. Prohibits manufacturers from replacing prohibited chemicals with a chemical designated as a chemical of high concern under Minnesota Statutes § 116.9402.

Provides an immediate effective date.
