Overview

This bill allows adoptive parents to seek reimbursement for child care expenses when an adult caregiver is employed and the other caregiver is disabled.

Section

- 1 Reimbursement for special nonmedical expenses.** Amends § 259A.20, subd. 4. Allows adoption assistance payments for child care if an adult caregiver is employed full-time and the other caregiver is disabled. Current law allows payment for child care when all adult caregivers are employed or attending educational or vocational training.
