Overview

This bill allows adoptive parents to seek reimbursement for child care expenses when an adult caregiver is employed and the other caregiver is disabled.

Section

Reimbursement for special nonmedical expenses. Amends § 259A.20, subd. 4. Allows adoption assistance payments for child care if an adult caregiver is employed full-time and the other caregiver is disabled. Current law allows payment for child care when all adult caregivers are employed or attending educational or vocational training.
