### Overview

This bill modifies driving rules for motor vehicles that relate to bicycle lanes and yielding to bicyclists.

#### Section

- 1 Passing on the right.** Prohibits a motor vehicle from passing on the right by driving in a bicycle lane. Under the traffic regulations in state statutes, a “bicycle lane” is a portion of the roadway or shoulder that is marked for use by bicyclists.
- 2 Laned highway.** Clarifies that a motor vehicle may drive in a bicycle lane when performing parking maneuvers.
- 3 Turning at intersection.** Modifies driving rules for making turns that cross into an adjacent bicycle lane, so that a driver must (1) signal prior to making the movement, (2) move only if safe to do so, (3) yield to bicycles that pose an immediate hazard.
