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## Overview

Makes school social work services and school psychological services provided as individualized education program health-related services eligible for medical assistance payment. Gives school districts some flexibility in documenting eligibility for reimbursement.

## **Section**

- Special education services. (a) Allows school districts to use the EBD (emotional or behavioral disorder) evaluation instead of a diagnostic assessment when seeking reimbursement for individualized education program health-related mental health services. Allows school districts to substitute an individualized education program, behavior intervention plan, or student progress review for the individual treatment plan, crisis plan, or 90-day required review as documentation for reimbursement.
  - (i) Makes school social work services provided as individualized education program healthrelated services eligible for medical assistance payment. Describes and gives examples of eligible school social work services and the conditions for reimbursement.
