## Overview

Establishes a Minnesota math corps program to give ServeMinnesota Americorps members a math instruction model to use in providing instructional support to elementary and middle school students and their teachers and help the students meet state math standards. Appropriates money.

## Section

**Reading and math corps.** Changes the name of the Minnesota reading corps program from ServeMinnesota Innovation to ServeMinnesota Americorps.

Establishes a Minnesota math corps program to give ServeMinnesota Americorps members a math instruction model they can use to provide instructional support to elementary and middle school students and their teachers and help the students meet state math standards.

Directs the education commissioner to submit a biennial evaluation report to the legislature to determine program efficacy.

Makes this section effective July 1, 2013.

**Appropriation. Minnesota math corps program.** Appropriates \$1,000,000 on fiscal year 2014 and \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2015 from the general fund to the commissioner of education for the Minnesota math corps program. Allows unexpended funds to carry forward to the next fiscal year.

Makes this section effective July 1, 2013
