Overview

Most revenue received by school districts is based on the number of students served by that school district and state aid is paid directly to the serving school district. However, the Department of Education is directed to make certain other aid adjustments for students receiving educational services outside the district of residence. The biggest adjustment is for the tuition billing of unreimbursed special education costs to the resident school district.

The bill removes obsolete language specific to fiscal year 2006 from the alternative attendance aid adjustment.
