Overview

Allows the Board of Teaching to issue up to three temporary one-year teaching licenses to otherwise qualified teacher license candidates who do not pass the teacher skills exam. Allows a teacher who is employed by a district and has been issued three temporary one-year teaching licenses to continue teaching in the district, at the district's request, but without acquiring continuing contract or seniority rights.

Section

License and rules. (b) Directs the Board of Teaching to adopt rules requiring a person to attempt to pass the teacher skills exam before entering a teacher preparation program. Requires preparation program providers to use the exam results of a person who does not pass the skills exam to identify areas of deficiency where the person needs remedial assistance. Requires teacher licensure candidates to pass the skills exam as a condition of receiving an initial teaching license.

Makes this section effective for the 2016-2017 school year and later.

Teacher and support personnel qualifications. (c) Allows the board of teaching to issue up to three temporary one-year teaching licenses to a person who has not passed the teacher skills exam but is otherwise qualified for a teaching license so that during that time the person may retake the skills exam, multiple times if needed. Allows a person who is employed by a school district to teach, has been issued three temporary one-year teaching licenses, and who has not passed the skills exam to continue teaching for the district, at the district's request, under a temporary license but precludes the person from acquiring continuing contract or seniority rights within the district.

Makes this section immediately effective.
