Overview

This bill requires schools to inform a child's parent, legal guardian, or custodian when there has been an incident in a school facility that may constitute maltreatment of the child.

Section

- **Maltreatment data.** Amends §13.43, subd. 14. Allows personnel data to be released to a child's parent, legal guardian, or custodian when a school receives information regarding an incident that may constitute maltreatment of a child in a school facility.
- **Report; information provided to parent.** Amends §626.556, subd. 7. Requires a school, whether or not a report of child maltreatment has been made, to inform a child's parent, legal guardian, or custodian if an incident has occurred that may constitute maltreatment of the child, when the incident occurred, and the nature of the conduct that may constitute maltreatment.
