Overview

This bill appropriates money from the general fund to the commissioner of health for grants to the University of Minnesota and the Mayo Clinic Foundation for the development and implementation of the Decade of Discovery in Diabetes Program.

Section

1 Decade of discovery in diabetes. Appropriates \$5,000,000 in fiscal year 2014 and \$5,000,000 in fiscal year 2015 from the general fund to the commissioner of health for development and implementation of the Decade of Discovery in Diabetes Program. The appropriation will provide grants to the University of Minnesota and the Mayo Clinic Foundation to develop (1) statewide prevention and care delivery initiatives; (2) research; (3) public education programs; and (4) other transformative initiatives. The institutions are required to produce an annual report.
