## Overview

Amends the law governing charter school enrollment preferences to include preK-6 charter schools located in a township. Requires such charter schools to give an enrollment preference to students and their siblings who reside within a five-mile radius of the charter school.

## **Section**

Admission requirements. Requires a charter school that is located in a township and serves students in pre-kindergarten through grade 6 to give enrollment preferences to the students and their siblings who reside within a five-mile radius of the school.

Makes this section effective for the 2014-2015 school year and later.
