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**Subject:** Criteria for Comprehensive and Primary Stroke Centers

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### Overview

This bill requires comprehensive and primary stroke centers to participate in the Minnesota stroke registry program in addition to already required certification.

#### Section

- 1 Comprehensive stroke center.** Amends § 144.493, subdivision 1. States that in addition to the requirement under current law of certification by the joint commission or other nationally recognized accreditation entity, a hospital must now also participate in the Minnesota stroke registry program in order to be considered a comprehensive stroke center.
- 2 Primary stroke center.** Amends § 144.493, subdivision 2. States that in addition to the requirement under current law of certification by the joint commission or other nationally recognized accreditation entity, a hospital must now also participate in the Minnesota stroke registry program in order to be considered a primary stroke center.
