Overview

This bill provides grants to the Minnesota Housing Finance Agency for pilot projects to assist families with children with disabilities in achieving homeownership.

Section

Appropriation. This bill provides funding for a pilot project with grants through the Minnesota Housing Finance Agency to eligible families. Families with children under the age of 19 with a medically diagnosed disability and who have faced housing instability as renters due to the child's disability in the last two years are eligible for the program.

\$600,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the City of Lakes Community Land Trust to help eligible families purchase a home through their program.

\$600,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Twin Cities Habitat for Humanity to help eligible families achieve homeownership.
