### Overview

This bill requires enhanced notification to victims of domestic violence and crimes of violence of the offender's zip code upon release from custody.

**1 Disclosure.** Authorizes disclosure of private or confidential court services data to crime victims as provided in section 2.

**2 Offender location.** Adds a new subdivision to § 611A.06 – Right to Notice of Release.

Provides that upon request, the commissioner of corrections or its designee shall disclose, to a victim of domestic violence or a crime of violence, enhanced notification of the zip code of the offender's residency upon release from custody, unless the offender is not under supervision, the zip code is unavailable, or disclosure creates a risk.

Classifies the victim's identifying data as private data on individuals.
