Overview

This bill appropriates funds to the commissioner of human services for projects to identify and serve high-risk children and youth.

Section

- Collaborative services for high-risk children and youth. Creates § 256.9951. Instructs the commissioner of human services to fund one or more projects to provide services to youth who are at high risk for child maltreatment, substance abuse, mental illness, or committing serious or violent offenses. Requires the projects to use multidimensional screening tools to identify youth in need of services and requires specified program components.
- **Appropriation.** Appropriates an unspecified amount from the general fund in fiscal year 2015 to the commissioner of human services to fund services described in section 1.
