- **Appropriation.** Appropriates \$500,000 to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a women entrepreneurs business development competitive grant program to facilitate creation and expansion of high growth, high revenue businesses by women.
- **Definition.** Defines terms used in the bill. A women-owned business is one that is owned or controlled by a female and organized for profit. A high economic impact firm is one that is projected to generate at least \$500,000 in annual revenue and create at least 10 high quality jobs (those paying an annual income of at least 150 percent of the federal poverty guideline adjusted for a family size of four).
- 3 Use of funds. Directs that funds may be used for training, mentoring and technical assistance; development of investor networks; and development of a recruitment program for women.
