This bill allows for a person to apply for a limited license within the purview of the ignition interlock program if the person's license was (1) revoked due a manslaughter criminal vehicular homicide conviction, or (2) suspended due to a certification or charge of criminal vehicular operation in which alcohol was involved and that resulted in some degree of bodily harm but not death.

A limited license provides driving privileges under specific, limited circumstances (such as for work, school, and child care).
