- Nursing mothers. Modifies the requirement in section 181.939 that employers must make reasonable efforts to provide space to employees that are nursing mothers to specify that the space should not be a bathroom and that it should be shielded from view, free from intrusion from coworkers and the public, and include access to an electrical outlet. Makes violation of the law an unfair employment practice under the state Human Rights Act.
- Nursing mothers. Provides a cross reference in the Human Rights Act to make violations of section 181.939 an unfair employment practice.
