Overview

This bill appropriates funds to the commissioner of human services to develop a training curriculum on the Civil Commitment Act.

Section

1 Appropriation. Appropriates \$35,000 from the general fund in fiscal year 2015 to the commissioner of human services to develop an online training program on the Civil Commitment Act to help county and hospital staff and mental health providers interpret and understand the act as it applies to people with mental illness. Lists the organizations that must be involved in developing the curriculum.
