- Postconviction relief; filing. Amends the filing requirement for a petition for postconviction relief. Eliminates the requirement of filing three copies with the court, and instead, requires filing of proof of service on the attorney general and county attorney.
- **Restitution; procedures.** Amends a provision related to notice of a request for restitution. Strikes language allowing notice on the offender's attorney to be deemed notice to an offender. (Background: A restitution request may occur after the conclusion of the criminal case and counsel may no longer be representing the offender.)
