Overview

Proposes a grant program to help students develop 21st century skills.

Section

1 21st century skills development pilot project.

Subd. 1. Pilot project. Establishes a 21st century skills development pilot project to develop important skills. Makes after-school and summer school providers using nontraditional learning opportunities eligible for pilot program funding. Allows eligible interested providers to apply to the education commissioner. Directs the commissioner to give priority to community-based partnerships of after-school providers when awarding grants.

Subd. 2. Appropriation. Appropriates an unspecified general fund amount in fiscal year 2015 to the education commissioner for the grants.
