Overview

This bill (1) allows some special oversize and overweight motor vehicle permits, to expire when the vehicle registration expires; and (2) provides for proportional reductions in permit fees using the new expiration date, based on the length of time remaining for the permit.

Section

- **Expiration date.** Allows for expiration of special harvest season increase permits at the same time as the end of the registration period for the vehicle.
- **Expiration date.** Allows for expiration of special forest products permits at the same time as the end of the registration period for the vehicle.
- **Fees; proceeds deposited; appropriation.** Requires a proportionally reduced special permit fee when the permit expiration is set to correspond with the end of the vehicle registration period.
- **Expiration date.** Allows for expiration of special pulpwood vehicle permits at the same time as the end of the registration period for the vehicle.
- **Expiration date.** Allows for expiration of special agricultural products permits at the same time as the end of the registration period for the vehicle.
- **Permit fee; appropriation.** Makes a conforming clarification, on proportional reductions in permit fees (see section 3).
