Overview

This bill requires the commissioners of health and human services to establish a health care homes advisory committee. The bill provides for, among other things, the membership and duties of the committee.

Section

- 1 Health care homes advisory committee.** Amends § 256B.0751 by adding subdivision 10.
- (a) Requires the commissioners of health and human services to establish a health care homes advisory committee.
 - (b) Requires the committee to include representatives from health care professions and requires at least 25 percent of the committee members to be consumers or patients in health care homes.
 - (c) Requires the committee to advise the commissioners on ongoing implementation of the health care programs, including, but not limited to, activities such as implementation of health care homes, potential modifications of the health care home rules or statutes, and consumer engagement.
 - (d) Allows the committee to establish subcommittees on specific topics. States that the committee expires June 30, 2018.
