Overview

Directs the board of teaching to enter into reciprocity agreements with other states identified by the board to allow fully certified out-of-state teachers to receive a Minnesota teaching license.

Section

Interstate reciprocity agreement for teacher licensure. Directs the board of teaching to enter into an interstate agreement for teacher licensure to allow fully certified teachers from other states that the board identifies to transfer their certification to Minnesota and receive a full, five-year continuing teaching license without having to complete any additional exams or other preparation requirements. Excludes out-of-state applicants holding only a provisional teaching license.
