Overview

This bill contains a variety of drug sentencing reforms.

Section

- 1 Subsequent controlled substance offense. Establishes that a prior drug diversion does not count as a prior drug offense for purposes of aggravated drug sentencing.
- **First degree sale crimes.** Doubles the threshold amounts needed to secure a conviction for a first degree controlled substance sale offense.
- **First degree possession crimes.** Doubles the threshold amounts needed to secure a conviction for first degree controlled substance possession offenses.
- **Second degree sale crimes.** Doubles the threshold amounts needed to secure a conviction for second degree controlled substance sale offenses.
- **Second degree possession crimes.** Doubles the threshold amounts needed to secure a conviction for second degree controlled substance possession offenses.
- **Third degree sale crimes.** Doubles the threshold amounts needed to secure a conviction for third degree controlled substance sale offenses.
- **Third degree possession crimes.** Doubles the threshold amounts needed to secure a conviction for third degree controlled substance possession offenses.
- **Aggravated controlled substance crime.** Creates a new level of controlled substance offense to target drug king pins offenders who traffic large quantities of controlled

substances.

- **SGC members.** Specifies that the chair of the sentencing guidelines commission must be a public member of the commission.
- **SGC appointment terms.** Staggers terms for members of the SGC.
- SGC modifications. Directs the SGC to establish and implement criteria to aid in determining proportionality of sentences under the guidelines.
