Adjusts the point that disabled veterans are eligible for in competitive open hiring processes. For a disabled veteran in a competitive examination rating, the points increase from 15 to 20. For a disabled veteran in a competitive promotional examination, the points increase from 5 to 20. The definition of disabled veteran is also modified. For open examinations, a disabled veteran is one with at least a 30 percent service-connected disability. For promotional preference, the definition of disabled veteran is lowered from 50 percent service-connected disability to 30 percent.
