Overview

The Minnesota Personal Protection act requires the commissioner of public safety to annually publish a list of states that have laws governing the issuance of permits to carry weapons that are not substantially similar to Minnesota's laws regarding permits to carry weapons. North Dakota is on the current version of this list which means North Dakota's permits are not recognized in Minnesota. An individual with a permit from a state that is **not** on this list may use the license or permit in Minnesota, subject to specified requirements. This bill amends the Minnesota Personal Protection Act to recognize the North Dakota permit to carry a pistol as valid within Minnesota.
