Overview

This bill modifies certain snowmobile registration requirements for smaller snowmobiles typically designed for youth.

Section

1 Nontrail use registration. Amends § 84.82, subd. 2a. Reduces the fee for registering smaller snowmobiles (those with an engine displacement less than 125 cubic centimeters) for nontrail use from \$45 to \$6. The registration is valid for three years. Snowmobiles registered for nontrail use may not be operated on state or grant-in-aid snowmobile trails.

The nontrail use snowmobile registration option was established in 2013 to provide a reduced rate for those not using state or grant-in-aid snowmobile trails. Legislation combining snowmobile registration and snowmobile trail sticker requirements was originally passed in 2012.
