### Overview

This bill appropriates funds for chemical dependency prevention programs in secondary schools.

#### Section

- 1 Appropriation; chemical dependency prevention programs.** Appropriates \$150,000 in fiscal year 2016 and in fiscal year 2017 from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for grants to provide chemical dependency prevention programs in secondary schools. Requires grantees to have prior experience providing chemical dependency prevention programs, to demonstrate expertise, and to provide matching funds. Provides that unspent funds cancel at the end of each fiscal year.
