### Overview

The bill modifies the requirements around daily commercial vehicle inspection reporting when no defects or deficiencies are found.

#### Section

- 1 Driver; daily inspection, report.** Eliminates a required report on daily inspection of a commercial motor vehicle, if no defects or deficiencies are identified and the vehicle is not used to carry passengers. Makes conforming changes.
- 2 Driver; pretrip inspection.** Limits required pretrip inspection report review and safety verification to the first time a vehicle is operated following completion of an inspection report.
- 3 Exceptions.** Makes a conforming technical clarification (to reproduce a requirement contained in a cross reference).
