### Section

- 1 Exemptions from licensing.** Provides an exemption to state electrical licensing requirements for mining company employees while performing work that is incidental to mining operations. The mining company must have a mining permit for its employees to qualify for the exemption. An individual who is unlicensed but registered with the commissioner of labor and industry while seeking an electrical license, may have hours of work at the mining company verified by a master electrician or an electrical engineer working for the mining company.
