Currently, a local board of appeal and equalization must have one member at each meeting who has taken a department of revenue course on appeal and equalization. This bill would restrict application of this requirement unless the commissioner of revenue offers a prescribed number of in-person training sessions to local board members. The requirement to offer in-person training sessions sunsets when the office of broadband development certifies that every jurisdiction subject to the current requirement has broadband service available.
