This bill establishes various requirements around Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) transportation planning, agency performance targets, efficiency and innovation measures, agency organizational restructuring, and legislative reporting. Provisions include:

- requiring a performance, stewardship, and sustainability plan for the state's transportation system, with a number of required plan components identified;
- reallocation of MnDOT staff if certain performance targets are not met;
- creating a new office for innovating projects and asset management, with duties to develop various best practices specified; and
- directing an organization effectiveness review and assessment of staffing, organizational structure, and trunk highway system operations, to be performed by university schools and centers.
