When a local assessor's office is terminated, assessment duties are transferred to the county assessor. Currently, there are three ways a local assessor's office can be terminated: by resolution of a board of county commissioners (with respect to cities with a population of less than 30,000), by joint agreement between a town or city and a county, or due to an unfilled vacancy in the local assessor's office lasting 90 days or more. This bill allows for the termination of a town's local assessor's office by a vote at a town's annual meeting.
