This bill amends traffic violations under Minnesota Statutes, section 169.444, by increasing the minimum fine from \$300 to \$500. Under Minnesota Statutes, section 169.444, it is a misdemeanor to fail to stop for a school bus displaying a stop arm or illegally pass on the right of a school bus flashing amber lights.
