Overview

This bill requires eyelash extension technicians to be regulated by the Board of Cosmetologist Examiners.

Section

- 1 **Eyelash extensions.** Amends § 155A.23, by adding subd. 4a. Provides the definition of “eyelash extensions.”
- 2 **Eyelash technician.** Amends § 155A.23, by addition subd. 4b. Provides the definition of “eyelash technician.”
- 3 **Manager.** Amends 2015 Supplement, § 155A.23, subd. 8. Modifies the definition of “manager” by including an eyelash technician to the list of individuals who can act as a manager if certain requirements are met.
- 4 **Practitioner.** Amends 2015 Supplement, § 155A.23, subd. 18. Adds a person licensed to provide eyelash technology services to the definition of “practitioner.”
- 5 **Licensing.** Amends 2015 Supplement, § 155A.27, subd. 1. Adds that an eyelash technician must be licensed in order to practice in this state.
- 6 **Continuing education requirements.** Amends 2015 Supplement, § 155A.271. Strikes an obsolete date. Adds that eyelash technicians must complete four hours of continuing education credits during the three years prior to license renewal.
- 7 **Licensing.** Amends 2015 Supplement, §155A.29, subd. 1. Adds eyelash extension salons to the types of salons that may be licensed by the board.

Section

- 8** **Effective date; application.** The bill is effective the day following final enactment. Provides that the Board of Cosmetology must not enforce the provisions relating to eyelash technicians until July, 1, 2017. Provides that any educational or training requirements for eyelash technicians must be 14 hours.
