In general, this bill would shield a person who provides an off-farm agricultural-related education program or demonstration from liability for a participant's injury, damage, or death occurring as a result of the inherent risk of the agricultural program or demonstration.

The bill would accomplish this by extending the legal protections for on-farm agritourism activities that were enacted in last session's omnibus agriculture policy law (Laws of Minnesota 2015, chapter 44, section 36).
