Overview

This bill requires foster care providers to receive training on fetal alcohol spectrum disorders.

Section

- 1 Child foster care training requirement; mental health training; fetal alcohol spectrum disorders training.** Amends Minnesota Statutes 2015 Supplement, § 245A.175. Adds a requirement for child foster care providers to have one hour of training on fetal alcohol spectrum disorders during the first 12 months of licensure. In following years, it allows training on fetal alcohol spectrum disorders to count toward the annual 12 hours of required in-service training.
