This bill makes it a misdemeanor to knowingly operate an unmanned aerial vehicle within one mile of a public safety helicopter (that is, one operated by a law enforcement agency, fire department, or emergency medical service provider) during its operations, unless the operator receives permission from the public safety entity. It creates a penalty enhancement to a gross misdemeanor for second or subsequent offenses.
