Overview

The Deer River school district is located in Itasca and Cass Counties, covers an area of about 540 square miles, and serves approximately 900 students.

This bill requests a \$2.9 million appropriation from the state bond proceeds fund for purposes of acquiring and renovating an existing facility to use as a multiage community center for programs including early childhood education, Boys and Girls Club activities, senior citizen services, and for other community needs.

Section

- 1 Deer River multiage center.** Appropriates \$2.9 million from the state bond proceeds fund for a grant to Independent School District No. 317, Deer River, to acquire and renovate a building for a multiage center. Authorizes the state to sell and issue \$2.9 million in general obligation bonds to provide the appropriation.
