## Overview

Under the postsecondary enrollment options program, 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students may enroll in a concurrent enrollment course if, after 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students have applied to take the course, additional students are needed for the school to be able to offer the course. This bill proposes to allow 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students to also enroll in a world languages concurrent enrollment course.

## **Section**

**1 Authorization; notification.** Allows 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students enrolled in a school district or an American Indian-controlled tribal contract or grant school to enroll in a concurrent enrollment world languages course.
