Section

- 1 Adoption of code.** Requires that updates to the state building code be done on a six year cycle. Once amendments to the code are adopted, the implementation of the updates must occur over a one year period before the changes may be enforced.
- 2 Copies of the code.** Requires that copies of the code, including updates done by reference to other codes, be provided free of charge.
- 3 International residential code.** Delays the effective date of the most current code changes, including those related to residential fire sprinkler systems, until July 24, 2015.
