Overview

The Works Museum, located in Bloomington, provides hands on exhibits focused on engineering activities designed for children and their families.

The 2014 Legislature appropriated \$75,000 in fiscal year 2015 on a onetime basis for a grant to The Works Museum.

This bill appropriates \$100,000 each year for The Works Museum for hands-on elementary engineering education programs and exhibits.
