Overview

Provides districts with full funding for the college concurrent enrollment program. Provides professional development opportunities for teachers who deliver concurrent enrollment courses.

Section

- 1 Concurrent enrollment program aid.** Makes all districts eligible for concurrent enrollment aid equal to \$150 per pupil enrolled in a concurrent enrollment course.
Makes this section effective for revenue for fiscal year 2016 and later.
- 2 Annual general education aid appropriation.** Makes an annual general fund appropriation to the department of education for concurrent enrollment aid.
Makes this section effective for revenue for fiscal year 2016 and later.
- 3 Appropriation; concurrent enrollment aid.** (a) Appropriates unspecified sums in fiscal years 2016 and 2017 from the general fund to the commissioner of education for concurrent enrollment aid.

(b) Allocates unspecified sums appropriated in paragraph (a) for teachers who deliver concurrent enrollment courses to attend professional development activities, training programs, and follow-up support workshops approved by the National Alliance of Concurrent Enrollment Partnerships.
