Overview

Provides districts with full funding for the college concurrent enrollment program. Provides professional development opportunities for teachers who deliver concurrent enrollment courses.

Section

- 1 Concurrent enrollment program aid. Makes all districts eligible for concurrent enrollment aid equal to \$150 per pupil enrolled in a concurrent enrollment course.
 - Makes this section effective for revenue for fiscal year 2016 and later.
- **Annual general education aid appropriation.** Makes an annual general fund appropriation to the department of education for concurrent enrollment aid.
 - Makes this section effective for revenue for fiscal year 2016 and later.
- **Appropriation; concurrent enrollment aid.** (a) Appropriates unspecified sums in fiscal years 2016 and 2017 from the general fund to the commissioner of education for concurrent enrollment aid.
 - (b) Allocates unspecified sums appropriated in paragraph (a) for teachers who deliver concurrent enrollment courses to attend professional development activities, training programs, and follow-up support workshops approved by the National Alliance of Concurrent Enrollment Partnerships.
