Overview

This bill requires the commissioner of management and budget to develop and implement a return on taxpayer investment methodology to evaluate corrections and human services programs.

Section

Appropriation; return on taxpayer investment. Appropriates \$100,000 in fiscal year 2016 and \$100,000 in fiscal year 2017 to the commissioner of management and budget to evaluate corrections and human services programs using the Pew-MacArthur Results First framework. Instructs the commissioner to work with various agency and county personnel, legislative staff, and stakeholders to implement the methodology developed during the evaluation. Requires the commissioner to issue a report to the governor and legislature by January 31, 2017.
