Overview

Requires school districts to contract with a student information system vendor employing a universal filing system that facilitates the seamless transfer of student due process records for a student with disabilities who transfers between school districts. Repeals the statute directing the education commissioner to customize a statewide online reporting system and requiring school districts to use the system for compliance reporting beginning in the 2018-2019 school year.

Section

- 1 Student information systems; transferring records.** Allows school districts using an online case management reporting system to contract only with a student information system vendor that employs a universal filing system to facilitate the seamless transfer of student due process records for a student with disabilities who transfers between school districts, regardless of what filing system any one district uses.

Makes this section effective immediately and applicable to all district contracts with a student information system vendor entered into or modified after that date.
- 2 Repealer.** Repeals the statutory section, Minnesota Statutes, section 125A.085, directing the commissioner of education to customize a statewide online system to collect and report required special education-related data and requiring school districts, beginning in the 2018-2019 school year and later, to use this online system for compliance reporting.

Makes this section effective July 1, 2015.
