Overview

This bill creates a legislative task force on child protection.

Section

1 **Legislative task force; child protection.** Creates a legislative task force to review implementation of the recommendations presented by the Governor's Task Force on the Protection of Children. Allows the task force to examine related areas of the child welfare system and to identify additional issues that need to be addressed by the legislature.

The four legislators serving on the governor's task force make up the legislative task force, with up to eight additional legislators appointed as ex officio members.

Requires the task force to issue a report and recommendations to the legislature by February 1, 2016, and provides that the task force expires the last day of the 2016 legislative session.
